-Helping children and teachers with foreign languages. Organizing workshops.

-Shaping local society towards being more open, tolerant and aware of the fact that there are people that are different from us. Participating in local events/festivals

-Showing teachers new methods of teaching and also learning their teaching methods.

-Helping students to achieve their goals, motivate them to setting higher goals and giving them the skills and knowledge to do so.

-Organizing culture days, speaking clubs, clean-up events, tree-planting...

-Introducing your culture to our society. Helping them to be more open-minded with your actions.

# WHAT WILL YOU GAIN?



-Getting experience in working with children and people with special needs.

-Be familiar with Polish education system and teaching methods in kindergarten and schools.

-Presentation skills. Management and marketing skills, while preparing events. -Develop facilitation skills by preparing and conducting workshops, classes and courses.

-Improving your language skill - English, learning Polish, teach your mother tongue.

-Gain higher level of confidence and self-esteem.

-Getting to know many places in Poland.

-Having a portfolio of workshops that you can use after the project. -Knowledge of non-formal education methods.

-Working experience in an intercultural environment. Participating in various trainings and workshops.

-All of your learning outcomes will be summarized in the Youthpass certificate.

# ACCOMODATION

- Volunteers will live in rooms in ESC flats (kitchen, bathrooms and all standard equipment).
- Volunteers usually will share room with another volunteer.
- Our flats are located in a walking distance to workplace.
- Internet connection is provided by organization, free access.



# INSURANCE AND WORKING HOURS

- Each volunteer have an insurance with HENNER company, which means free access to Polish doctors of all kinds including dentists.
- Volunteers will be working appr. 35 hours per week, and will have 2 days off per month of holidays, Saturdays and Sundays are mostly free, and Friday usually is for evaluation and workshops with other volunteers.

# FOOD AND POCKET MONEY

Every volunteer will receive **6 EUR** per day of pocket money (in accordance with the program rules), and additionally money for food.

In total around 1100 PLN per month. Enough for living in a small town for a month and even travelling in a budget way;) Volunteer will have his/her own bank account and money will be transferred there automatically every month.

# MILICZ-POLAND

-Project will take place in Milicz, it is a small city occupied by 11 000 citizens. 50 km from Wrocław (0,7 million citizens). By train it takes just 40 min to get there.

-In Milicz there is a sport centrum (free access for volunteers: indoor and outdoor swimming pool, sauna, fitness... )

-Hundreds of km bike roads, beautiful nature, mountains and skiing in the south of Poland. (4 hours to Milicz. )
